B. Purpose of Proposed Activity

Description of activity

Hokitika Museum Collection Policy for new donations:

⁶5. Acquisition 5.1 Guidelines

The museum subscribes to a process of selective acquisition and is under no obligation to accept all items offered to it. The museum will not acquire any items which do not fit within its collection policy or for which it is unable to provide adequate physical protection, care and documentation. Where necessary items in the museum's collection may be selected for deaccessioning (see appendix 2).

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5.2 Co-operation and consultation

a. The museum recognises the need to co-operate and consult with members of the tangata whenua in relation to Maori cultural property.

- b. The museum also recognises the need to co-operate and consult with other museums and organisations with similar interests and collections.
- c. Material unsuitable for the Hokitika Museum will be directed to other more appropriate public museums wherever possible.

5.3 Conditions preventing acquisition

- a. The museum supports international efforts to prevent trafficking in stolen or illegally exported cultural material and will not acquire any item known to have been obtained illegally.
- b. The museum will not acquire any specimen that has been collected in contravention of any law for the protection of wildlife species.
- c. The museum will not acquire any object known to have been collected in circumstances which are unscientific or intentionally destructive or damaging to archaeological sites.
- d. The museum will not acquire any item known to have been collected in contravention of the Antiquities Act 1975.
- e. The museum will not acquire any item where ownership or title is not clear
- f. The museum will not acquire any item when unreasonable conditions are attached i.e permanent display."
