# **Oral Item: No New Mines on Conservation Land Update**

**Portfolio** 

Conservation

On 18 October 2022, the Cabinet Priorities Committee:

- noted that mining activities on conservation land are regulated under the Crown Minerals Act 1991, and Schedule 4 of the Act lists land classifications where access cannot be granted for most new mining activities;
- invited the Minister of Conservation to submit a paper to the Cabinet Environment, Energy and Climate Committee, which seeks agreement to amend Schedule 4 to implement the Government commitment of no new mines on conservation land, and includes consideration of advice on existing iwi rights where these relate to alluvial mining, and legislative options which allow for a timely amendment.
