We have considered your request under the Official Information Act 1982.

The booking data requested has been provided in the attached workbook. The metric used for these is bednights. A bednight is a single person staying for a single night, so for example one person staying for two nights at a hut will be recorded as two bednights, and two people staying for a single night will also be recorded as two bednights.

The first sheet within the workbook contains bednights for the four Great Walk huts requested, broken down by country (NZ or Other). Country is recorded at the individual occupant level for Great Walks.

The second sheet contains the same data for all other huts requested. Country is not collected for individual occupants at non-Great Walk facilities, and bednights are recorded as New Zealand or other based only on the country listed for the account holder making the booking. This dataset also contains bednights for Luxmore Hut outside the Great Walks season, when it is considered a Serviced hut.
