Tongariro National Park Machinery Inspection and Access

This document sets out the conditions & procedures for machinery inspections prior to access to Tongariro National Park (the Park), to carry out works. The Department's environmental and sustainable objective is to protect the park, from the introduction of unwanted soil-borne organisms, as machinery are potential carriers of aggregate seed threats.

These procedures apply to works carried out in Whakapapa Village and the Whakapapa, Turoa and Tukino Ski Area Boundaries.

You must:

- Complete the mandatory notification form to book an inspection or entry by exemption.
- Read, understand and comply with the 'Machinery Inspection and Access Conditions' – these are found in the form below.
- Give at least 24 hours notice (working days) prior to machinery entry to the park for an inspection or by exemption.
- Thoroughly clean and check machinery before organising an inspection, to avoid removal from the park for remediation works. This includes checking for any potential oil leaks.

Things to know

- Inspections between 0800 1600 hours or as agreed.
- Provisions have been made for machinery inspection exemptions. Any misuse will result in loss of this condition.
- Annual Review period of these procedures for two, 1 year terms; October 2022 and October 2023.
