Purpose – Te aronga

1. To advise on the prioritisation of certain proposals for Western South Island stewardship land.

Background and context - Te horopaki

- 2. The reclassification of stewardship land in the Western South Island, Te Tai Poutini, is in its final stages [25-B-0146 refers]. Your role is to decide whether to approve, or decline, each of the 576 reclassification proposals that were notified.
- 3. You have requested advice from DOC on the prioritisation of certain proposals:
 - i. Proposals to refer areas to the New Zealand Conservation Authority (NZCA) to consider the suitability of national park status.
 - ii. Proposals where Te Rūnanga of Ngāi Tahu (Ngāi Tahu) opposed the DOC section 49 recommendation.
- 4. Advice on the prioritisation of these proposals is set out below. The advice provided on these two bundles of proposals considers provisions in the General Policy for National Parks (GPNP), and the Ngāi Tahu interests as presented. Due to timeframe constraints, we have not undertaken further prioritisation based on an assessment of the conservation values or submissions received in relation to each affected stewardship area.
- 5. The context behind the notified national park proposals is included as Attachment A.

Summary Response

- 6. DOC recommends prioritising 13 national park proposals (27%) covering ~75,642 ha (98%). A table setting out this prioritisation is included as Attachment B.
- 7. Where Ngāi Tahu opposes DOC section 49 recommendations, we recommend you prioritise adhering to our advice where the matters raised are not tethered to a specific Treaty interest (40 DOC recommendations, 37% of Ngāi Tahu opposition). Ngāi Tahu opposition to individual national park proposals cannot be prioritised due to the blanket nature of the tribal position. A table setting out this prioritisation is included as Attachment C.

General Policy for National Parks provides criteria for national park additions

- 8. DOC has recommended you refer 48 national park proposals to the NZCA. All of these areas were considered to meet the primary criteria for national park additions in GPNP 6(a):
 - "Lands recommended for national park status will contain, for their intrinsic worth and for the benefit, use and enjoyment of the public, the following: i) scenery of such distinctive quality that its preservation in perpetuity is in the national interest; or ii) ecosystems or natural features so beautiful, unique or scientifically important that their preservation in perpetuity is in the national interest."
- 9. DOC has undertaken further prioritisation of these 48 national park proposals, considering criteria defined in the GPNP for consideration by the Authority, and Minister, before approving national park additions:
 - "6(b) Lands recommended for new national park status should be relatively large, preferably in terms of thousands of hectares, and preferably comprise contiguous areas or related areas; and should be natural areas.
 - 6(n) Wilderness areas should be large enough and sufficiently remote and buffered to be unaffected by human influences, except in minor ways, consistent with section 14(2) of the National Parks Act 1980."
- 10. Our prioritisation has also included instances where the relevant National Park Management Plan identifies suitable stewardship areas to be considered for national park status.
- 11. Based on the three criteria set out above, DOC recommends prioritising 13 national park proposals (27%) covering ~75,642 ha (98%). A table setting out this prioritisation is included as Attachment B.
- 12. We note that other criteria identified in the GPNP, particularly 6(i), require a further, more comprehensive, analysis in order to be considered:
 - "6(i) The following matters should be considered by the Authority before recommending, and by the Minister before approving, the boundaries of new parks, additions to existing national parks and changes to existing boundaries:
 - i) the need to protect natural, historical and cultural heritage in national parks from adverse effects of activities outside national park boundaries, and avoid any potential adverse effects of national park status on adjoining land;
 - ii) the goal of a representative range of ecosystems, natural features and scenery types being included in national parks;
 - o iii) landscape units:
 - iv) readily identifiable natural features;
 - o v) convenience for the efficient management of the national park:
 - vi) access options, consistent with the need to preserve national park values."

Our prioritisation of national park proposals considers only relevant matters under conservation legislation

- 13. In order to support legally robust decisions, our advice is based on considerations that are consistent with the purpose and scheme of conservation legislation [25-B-0224 refers]. There is no immediate scope to consider prioritisation based on the potential non-conservation-related uses for the land, and related economic implications (e.g. the presence of likely mineral deposits).
- 14. The NZCA has the unique discretion under conservation policy to consider the likely socio-economic implications of national park proposals. This is set out in GPNP 6(e) and 6(h)(v):
 - "6(e) Investigation reports on any proposal that land should be declared to be a national park or part of a national park should include an assessment of the likely social, recreational, cultural and economic implications for tangata whenua and local and regional communities, as well as the nation generally.
 - 6(h) The Authority may recommend additions or boundary adjustments to a national park without requesting a formal investigation, when the land to be added has been specifically acquired for national park purposes, and in other circumstances, including one or more of the following:
 - v) the land does not contain significant known mineral deposits with commercial potential which are economically viable for extraction."
- 15. The statutory scheme expects information regarding the socio-economic implications of national park proposals to be formulated via recommendations from the NZCA. This information would then be pertinent to your final decisions.
- 16. We have not used these criteria for our prioritisation as using them prior to consideration by the NZCA might invite a court to make adverse inferences, including that improper considerations materially influenced an outcome or that a decision was contrary to the purpose and scheme of conservation legislation.

Ngāi Tahu oppose 108 DOC section 49 recommendations

17. You have asked DOC to undertake further prioritisation of the 108 instances where Ngāi Tahu opposes the DOC section 49 recommendations. This is set out below:

- 18. Ngāi Tahu opposes 48 DOC recommendations to proceed with national park proposals. Due to the blanket nature of the opposition to all proposals, DOC was unable to recommend prioritising individual proposals based on the Ngāi Tahu interests as presented.
- 19. Exempting national park proposals, DOC recommends prioritising your decisions based on the nature of the interests identified by Ngāi Tāhu (Attachment C). The Ngāi Tahu opposition can be grouped into two broad areas:

• Ngāi Tahu specific interests - 20 proposals

- Reclassification proposals where Ngāi Tahu has identified specific Treaty interests associated with pounamu, forestry, climate change mitigation, and/or afforestation opportunities, and advocated to retain areas in stewardship to enable further assessment of the values and opportunities for Ngāi Tahu.
- Given the specific nature of the interests identified, DOC considers there is a higher risk of Ngāi Tahu challenge if you follow the section 49 recommendations in these instances. DOC recommends placing a lower priority on adhering to DOC advice regarding these proposals.

• Other matters - 40 proposals

- Reclassification proposals where Ngāi Tahu has stated general opposition, identified that areas are subject to other matters, including Fast-track applications, local infrastructure, climate mitigation planning, or future opportunities for the Crown and the West Coast community.
- Given the broad nature of the matters raised, which are not tethered to a specific Treaty interest, DOC considers there is a lower risk of Ngāi Tahu challenge if your follow the section 49 recommendations in these instances. DOC recommends placing a higher priority on adhering to DOC advice regarding these proposals.
- Within these 40 areas, there are four sites where there is an additional weighting that could be considered (two proposed for Conservation Park and two for Disposal). For the two conservation parks, DOC has accepted submission points expressing concern about the suitability of the proposals, while the two disposals are unlikely to meet Conservation General Policy disposal tests.
- 20. The prioritisation criteria that have been applied to your consideration of national park additions are unique to the General Policy for National Parks and the national park process, and are not applicable to other classification types.

Risk assessment – Aronga tūraru

21. Although the NZCA has discretion to consider the likely socio-economic implications of national park proposals, there is no immediate legislative scope for us to advise you on how to consider these factors apart from where they are raised by Treaty partners. Prioritising national park proposals based on considerations outside the scheme of conservation legislation would be ultra vires and could provide grounds for legal challenge.

Next steps – Ngā tāwhaitanga

22. This memo is intended to assist your decision-making for the substantive brief on Stewardship Land (25-B-0146 refers) so does not seek any new decisions. You have also received additional advice on two other matters you have raised (25-B-0224):

- i. The basis for recommending you provide justifications for your decisions, and whether this is a statutory requirement.
- ii. What proposals have been flagged by Ngāti Apa ki te Ra Tō (Ngāti Apa) regarding SILNA redress.
- 23. DOC officials are finalising a draft Cabinet paper, outlining your intention to make decisions regarding the reclassification of stewardship land in the Western South Island.

Attachment A - Context behind the national park proposals identified by the National Panel

- 1. Where the National Panel identified national park values, it was proposed "that a recommendation is sought from the New Zealand Conservation Authority for this area to be added to the adjacent National Park following the process set out in section 8(1) of the National Parks Act 1980".
- 2. All national park proposals were supported by the justification that "this conservation area is considered to have complementary conservation values to the adjacent section of the [specific] National Park. Adding this conservation area to the national park is considered to rationalise the park's boundary and improve landscape continuity."
- 3. Acknowledging the Ngāi Tahu position (opposing any national park additions), the National Panel was aware that further, more comprehensive, consideration by the New Zealand Conservation Authority would be needed to inform its recommendation as to whether you should implement each national park proposal.
- 4. The Panel did not consider the full range of factors that are listed in the General Policy for National Parks.

Priority 1 sites: meet one or more of the identified criteria

Priority 2 sites: do not meet the identified criteria but retain potential for further analysis through the NZCA process
