



Figure 12: Trevally trawl survey abundance, 1982 - 2000, overlaid on acoustic class background.









Figure 13: Rig trawl survey abundance, 1982 - 2000, overlaid on acoustic class background.








Figure 14: Barracouta trawl survey abundance, 1982 - 2000, overlaid on acoustic class background.









Figure 15: Kahawai trawl survey abundance, 1982 - 2000, overlaid on acoustic class background.








Figure 16: Historically abundant areas of green-lipped mussels. Two families dominated the mussel fishery. Mismatch of mussels and coastline in northeast is due to inaccuracies in the original map. Red dots denote ground truth stations.
