Catlins & MacLennan Roar Ballot

We advise you the following:

- This Hunting permit **DOES NOT GIVE YOU SOLE RIGHT OF ACCESS** to the block, it gives you sole right to hunt the block. Therefore there should be no other person hunting on this block that isn't on your permit **BUT THERE MAY BE OTHER PEOPLE IN THE BLOCK THAT ARE NOT HUNTING** e.g. DOC staff, possum trappers, research staff, trampers, school groups etc. **IDENTIFY YOUR TARGET CLEARLY.**
- If you are not going to hunt your block in Catlins & MacLennan, then please let the Department know so we can issue it to someone else. Demand for blocks is extremely high, particularly on the weekends. If you keep this in mind, it will mean more hunters that miss out on the ballot will have the opportunity to go for a hunt, perhaps including yourself.
